***Background***

This scholarship was created by Marie Biancuzzo to honor the memory of her father, Felix Biancuzzo, a truly self-made man who pursued opportunities for learning throughout the course of his lifetime. Born in 1915, Felix attended school and began working at age 9 to support his immigrant mother and siblings prior to and throughout the Great Depression. Later, he married the former Maria Cristini and together they raised three children. In recognition of his outstanding performance as a Ford franchisee, he was personally presented with an award by Henry Ford II. A dedicated worker throughout his life, Felix frequently gave his time, talents, and financial resources to the community.

***Purpose of Scholarship***

Breastfeeding Outlook is an organization that aims to support health care professionals in actively promoting, protecting, and supporting breastfeeding at the individual, interpersonal and system levels. We provide educational programs, publications, and materials for health care providers. With this scholarship Marie Biancuzzo recognizes individuals who are eager to provide evidence-based lactation support for breastfeeding mothers and their babies.

***Type of Award***

Winners of this scholarship will be eligible to attend the four-day *Comprehensive Lactation Course* at one location between July 1, 2018 and May 30, 2019 or to complete the all-online Lactation Consultant Core Concepts course. (See *Policies* section below for details.) Up to one full scholarship

(covering all course registration costs) and one partial scholarship (covering half of the course registration costs) will be awarded.

### **Eligibility**

1. Only **first-time** IBLCE exam candidates who are eligible to take the IBLCE exam between April 1, 2019 and October 30, 2019 may apply for the current scholarship cycle.
2. Previous winners of the Felix Biancuzzo Memorial Scholarship may not apply.

### **Policies**

1. This scholarship will cover only course registration fees (fully or in part) for the live Comprehensive Lactation Course or the online Lactation Consultant Core Concepts Course. Winner will be responsible for any travel, lodging or other costs incurred in the process of attending the live *Comprehensive Lactation Course*.
2. Winner must take the IBLCE exam prior to October 30, 2019.
3. Scholarship winners agree to have their name(s) and image(s) used in a press release and related public relations materials issued by Breastfeeding Outlook.
4. Scholarship applications must be submitted no later than 11:59 pm (Eastern Time) May 31, 2018. Winner(s) will be notified by July 1, 2018.

### **Scholastic Criteria**

The Felix Biancuzzo scholarship is not a need-based award. The winner(s) will be chosen by a Selection Committee comprised of Marie Biancuzzo and other Breastfeeding Outlook staff members according to the applicant's demonstrated ability to:

- Complete the scholarship application. Your application may be typed or handwritten, but must be easily legible.
- Initiate self-learning and develop own knowledge and skills.
- Become actively aware of and involved in professional or community service activities related to breastfeeding; preference will be given to those who have been active members of breastfeeding coalitions or groups.

### **Selection of Potential Winners**

- The Selection Committee reserves the right not to grant the award at this time if criteria are not met.

- Any and all decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final and not subject to appeal.


