I hope that my commitment to active learning is apparent in this unique publication. My aim was to give people many written exercises, because studies in the education field repeatedly show the value of doing, not just reading and/or highlighting.

I started the workbook shortly before Christmas of 2016. Admittedly, I rushed at the end, trying hard to make this available before you go to the IBLCE exam. Even though three people proof-read the workbook before it went to press, there are a few exercises that still have a problem:

- The discussion about plagiocephaly is correct on page 37. But Learning Exercise 3-3 in the appendix (*page 391*) is not quite right. Plagiocephaly is *caused* by not having enough tummy time, so the *intervention* is to have more (not less!) tummy time. (By the way, I would caution that plagiocephaly is largely an American thing; unless a country does the Back-to-Sleep campaign, plagiocephaly is unlikely to occur.)
- On page 397, Learning exercise 5-2, all volumes are in **ml/24 hours**.
